ejercicios y artilugios diversos para ayudarles a bajar de peso. Detrás de ello existe, por supuesto, un negocio montado que mueve más millones de pesetas al año que el que se invierte en mantener la salud. Y es que primero nos presenten los múltiples alimentos que podemos paladear, de sabor y color increíbles, para después, cuando nos han convencido para que los comamos, nos exijan que bajemos de peso y nos controlemos.
