Critics praised her first volume of poetry, *Moods*, in 1919 and predicted her rise to literary fame, but the love of other women that fueled her writing also limited her opportunities to fulfill this destiny. Failing to achieve any lasting fame, she died in relative poverty at the age of seventy-five. De Acosta lived her desires publicly with verve and vigor at a time when few others would dare, and for that, she paid the price of marginalized obscurity. Until now. With " That Furious Lesbian" Schanke at last establishes Mercedes de Acosta' s rightful place as a pioneer— and indeed a champion— in the early struggle for lesbian rights in this country. Robert A. Schanke has edited a companion to this biography, *Women in Turmoil: Six Plays by Mercedes de Acosta*, also available from Southern Illinois University Press.
