Warner Schaie and his colleagues describe problems and methods of studying natural cohorts within a longitudinal study and report the first data on adult parent-offspring similarity determined as a function of the age of the pair when studied. A commentary chapter by Ross A. Thompson concludes the volume.

The Neotropical area is a main setting of the earliest experiences of domestication of plants, and evolutionary processes guided by humans, which continue being active in the area.
